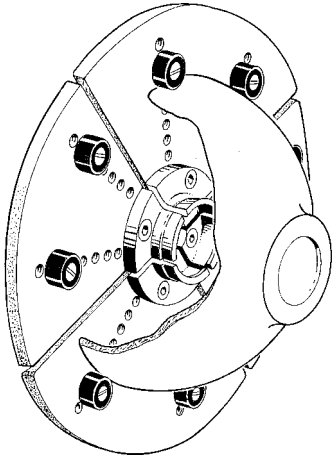

Cole Jaw Set



The Cole jaws are a versatile set designed primarily for the re-chucking of bowls to remove chuck marks or to re-shape the bottoms of bowls that have already been turned. Bowls up to 10" in diameter maximum can be accommodated. Customized MDF (medium density fiberboard) can be made (not supplied as accessory) to increase the holding diameter.

With the addition of the other chuck jaw sets, which can be fitted to the Cole jaws, a full range of facilities is available also - expanding dovetail facility for mounting bowls/platters and a reverse dovetail for mounting footed bowls/platters.

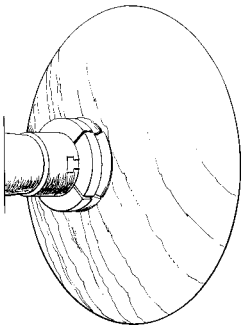
130mm Jaw Set



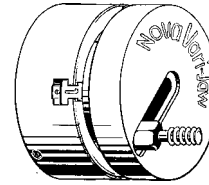
Essentially the big brother to the 100mm jaws. They are designed to handle very large work up to 29" in diameter.

An ideal 'companion' jaw for the SuperNova Chuck as the extra power of the SuperNova matches the big capacity of these jaws. No need to consider larger chucks or faceplates.

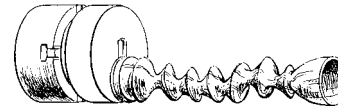
Provision to mount false wooden jaws (so that customized jaws can be made for special purposes)



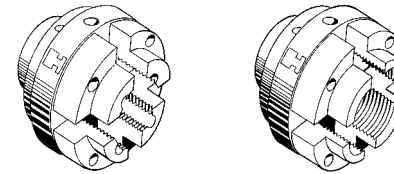
Vari Jaw Set



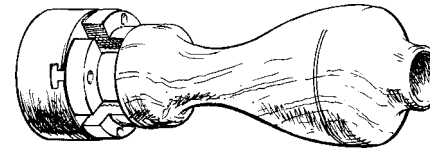
The Vari Jaws work on being able to adjust the centre point of your turning right from 'on center through to a 40mm offset. The dual combination of the offset plus the rotating adjustable hexagon screw means the Vari Jaws can produce an almost limitless range of effects.



Spigot Jaws



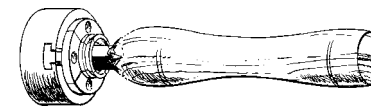
The Spigot Jaws are available in 2 different internal sizes, 35mm and 45mm. They are designed to grip in the contracting and in the expanding mode (with up to 10" long work piece) They are ideal for long, unsupported hollow boxes and vases. Their serrated tooth form makes for a very powerful grip that just won't let go.



Spur Centre



This rugged, 4 pronged Spur Drive fits snugly into the SuperNova or Nova jaws. The wedge shape of the prongs and their 4 cornered position enables them to penetrate and firmly grip the wood. For those who use their chuck most of the time, but who want to swap quickly for spindle work.

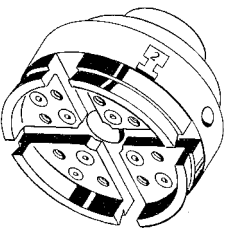
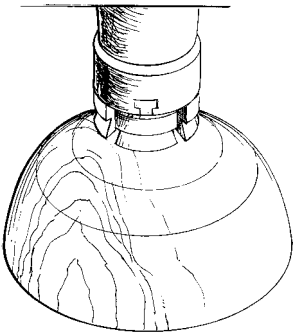

100mm Jaw Set

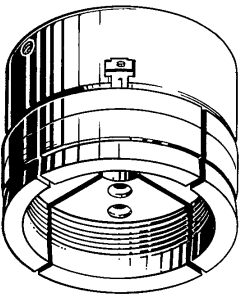
One of the most popular and versatile jaws for mid size turning work. They are made for a larger range of work than the standard 50mm Jaws or the Step Jaws.

The 100mm jaws are designed for an expanded dovetail grip (bowls up to 14"), reverse dovetail grip for gripping tooted bowls (feet up to 3 1/2"), limited spigot facility (up to 6" long) and provision to mount false wooden jaws (so that customized jaws can be made for special purposes)



Power Grip Jaw Set

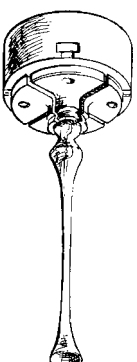
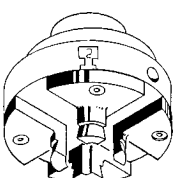
Introduced at the same time as the SuperNova and fast gaining in popularity. These are awesome jaws - best used in conjunction with the SuperNova, as the extra gripping power of that Chuck enhances the Power Grip's action. Able to hold large range of work up to 29" in diameter, but has the added advantage over the 130mm jaws, of being able to hold long spigots as well, up to 19" long!



25mm Jaw Set

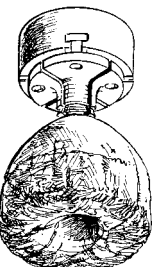
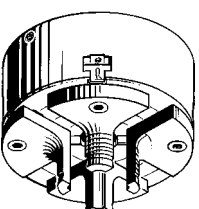
Quick and easy to use for small bowl (up to 6" in diameter) and small unsupported spigot turning work (up to 5" long)

These very popular jaws are ideal for gripping work below the size that can be handled by the standard 50mm jaws.



Pin Jaw Set

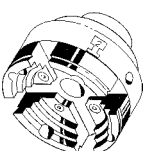
These jaws are a special extended version of the 25mm jaw set and are designed to act like a Pin chuck by expanding into a pre-bored hole. This is a useful technique for free form edge bowls. The real advantage though for the Pin Jaws is that you don't have to bore to an exact size as with Pin Chucks. The longer jaws allow for a very powerful spigot grip for smaller work like lace bobbins, (up to 6" in length) and has a dovetail facility for mounting small bowls, (up to 6" in diameter)



Step Jaw Set

These jaws are designed to grip in the contracting mode. The step sizes provide optimum gripping for 3 foot sizes with minimal crush damaged wood.

Also an expanding dovetail for alternative recess gripping of bowls. Can hold bowls up to 12" in diameter.



Vacuum Faceplate

Designed to fit onto the standard 50mm jaws, this provides a faceplate facility to enable you to vacuum chuck. Can be used in conjunction with Hand-wheel and Vacuum Coupler Unit Accessory for Nova 3000 and Nova Comet Woodlathes.
